



**Notification regarding admission in First semester in Govt. General Degree College in the Academic
Year 2025-26**

The passed-out students of Higher Secondary / equivalent examinations, who are interested to take admission in the Govt. General Degree Colleges of Tripura during the academic year 2025-26 are hereby informed that admission to the First Semester in B.A/B.Sc/B.Com (Major & Minor) Courses will be conducted as per the following schedule. Students are requested to apply online in the SAMARTH portal as per the schedule given below:

1	Date of submission of online application through SAMARTH portal. Eligible Students have to login to https://highereducation.tripura.gov.in or https://dhetripuraadmission.samarth.ac.in/index.php to access external link to SAMARTH Portal to apply.	: 23-05-2025 to 30-05-2025 upto 12 midnight.
2.	Date of publication of the Complete Merit List and the list of selected candidates for 1 st round admission in the College website and Notice board.	: 11-06-2025 at 3 PM
3.	1 st round admission (Physical admission in colleges with original testimonials).	: 13-06-2025 to 18-06-2024 upto 3 PM (except holidays)
4.	Publication of vacancy list after 1 st round admission (Subject wise vacancy position will be published by the colleges individually at College website and Notice board)	: 19-06-2025 at 3 PM
5.	Date of publication of selected candidates for admission in 2 nd round.	: 19-06-2025 at 3 PM
6.	2 nd round admission (Physical admission in colleges with original testimonials).	: 21-06-2025 to 25-06-2025 upto 3 PM (except holidays)
7.	Publication of vacancy list after 2 nd round admission (Subject wise vacancy position will be published by the colleges individually at College website, and Notice board)	: 27-06-2025 at 3 PM
8.	Starting of classes (Tentative date)	: 01-07-2025

- After 2nd round admission, if any vacancy is available, the remaining admission process will be carried out by the College authorities from the remaining candidates in the merit list. The notification of such vacancies and admission schedule shall be widely published by the respective colleges.
- All the applications are to be made in online mode only through the SAMARTH portal. No manual admission forms shall be entertained.
- Admission of any student will be finalized by the respective Colleges subject to verification of all original testimonials.
- Subject-wise intake capacity of all Colleges can be seen at the website of the Directorate and the Colleges.
- Information and Updates in respect of the 3 new GDCs namely, GDC Ambassa, GDC Kakraban and GDC Karbook will be available in the official website of the Higher Education Department, Tripura.



**Important Notice regarding admission in the First year of Govt. General Degree College in the
Academic year 2025-26**

1. From the Academic Year 2025-26 the entire admission process will be conducted in online mode only through SAMARTH Portal. There will be no scope to apply for admission in offline mode. So, students are advised to register himself/herself in SAMARTH Portal and apply for admission in Government Degree College of their choice.
2. The students need to go to the Web Portal of Directorate of Higher Education vide URL <https://highereducation.tripura.gov.in> or <https://dhetripuraadmission.samarth.ac.in/index.php> to access external link to SAMARTH, Government of India to apply to Colleges for admission in 1st semester, UG Programme.
3. The Students need to create individual Registration and Login ID to proceed further for applying online.
4. The Personal details as per requirement of the portal need to be given correctly by the students.
5. After registration, a candidate can apply to a maximum of 4 (Four) Colleges and per College upto 02 (two) Major Subjects of their choice can be selected.
6. While choosing the Colleges and subjects, utmost care must be taken, so that there is a high possibility of getting selected based on their own performance in the last Board Examination vis-a-vis the intake capacity in the subject they have opted for.
7. Selection of students will be done strictly on the basis of subject-wise merit list and the notified intake capacity of the respective Colleges. Merit list will be prepared by the college following the reservation policy of the State.
8. If a student fails to secure admission into any of the colleges applied for, he/she will be given a further opportunity to apply to colleges still having vacancy. Notification regarding this will be published in due time.
9. During registration, utmost care should be taken to fill up email-id & mobile number (provide own e-mail ID and Phone number for smooth communication), personal information as per application format, Aadhaar or Aadhaar enrolment number, Mathematics marks in Madhyamik examination, marks of various subjects taken in Higher Secondary examination, Photo and other relevant information in proper manner so that the registration is done properly.
10. Login credentials may be noted down for future reference. Candidates are also advised to take a print of the applications they made online at SAMARTH portal.
11. The merit list of students seeking admission in Major & Minor Courses will be prepared on the basis of Index Percentage. The Index percentage will be calculated on the basis of marks obtained in the best 5 subjects in H.S(+2) stage plus marks obtained in the subject in which Major is sought for and it will be divided by 6(six). As per the index percentage the merit list will be prepared by the Colleges individually and allotment of seats will be done for respective subjects maintaining all other criteria.
12. Students can make queries related to online admission in the admission helpdesk of the Colleges, helpdesk of the Higher Education Department, helpline number of Colleges from 10 A.M. to 5 P.M. and respective college's email given in the College web portal. The students may also take help of the Common Services Centres (CSC) of their locality, if needed.
13. Students should login and check at Smarth Portal on regular basis based on the admission timeline for admission related update.
14. Students should regularly check the website of the Colleges they have selected for admission related updates. Information and Updates in respect of the 3 new GDCs namely, GDC Ambassa, GDC Kakraban and GDC Karbook will be available in the official website of the Higher Education Department, Tripura.
